To Develop the Resource Management Plan for Alabama and Mississippi

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Jackson Field Office is preparing a Resource Management Plan (RMP) for Mississippi and Alabama. The RMP will establish the guidance, objectives, policies, and management actions for lands (tracts) and minerals under the administration of the BLM – for approximately 27 Public Domain tracts and about 152,100 acres of BLM-administered minerals (oil and gas and coal). The BLM invites you to attend the public workshop on **September 2, 2004** to provide comments and issues for consideration in the development of planning alternatives.
